Peer Tutor connects students in need of support with live help from their peers. Peer Tutor is available Monday to Thursday for students in 6<sup>th</sup> grade to 12<sup>th</sup> grade that are currently enrolled in any Math class from 6<sup>th</sup> grade Math through Geometry.

Our student peer tutors who offer this service are nominated by their teachers, must meet certain GPA requirements, receive training, and are skilled in the math courses they support. 


### **Accessing LiveTutor and Peer Tutor**

#### To access LiveTutor or Peer Tutor, follow these simple steps:

1. From your student home page, click the "Links" tab.



2. Click the LiveTutor link or the Peer Tutor link.




- 3. You will then enter a LiveLesson waiting room. When you enter the LiveLesson waiting room, locate the text box and type your:
  - Course
  - Unit/Lesson

- Page Number
- Problem Number



4. Wait in the waiting room until a tutor is available. When a tutor is available, you will be transferred into the LiveLesson room and will hear a doorbell sound to let you know that you have entered the LiveLesson room.
